


































OPD Support

INFECTED THERMAL BURN RAW WOUND WITH CONTRACTURE (ELBOW) LEFT UPPER LIMB WITH SEPTICEMIA

HISTORY

Baby. Aanya, 1.5 years, old female, patient was admitted in this hospital with complaints of K/C/O old themal burn wound with contracture left elbow (evolving/ partial- contracture, non healing wound at left fore arm) with pain at burn site and generalized weakness.

COURSE IN HOSPITAL

Patient admitted in hospital through casualty on 29.12.2020 under Dr. Ashok Kumar Verma with above mentioned complaints. After Initial evaluation as per standardised protocol treatment initiated with IV fluids, IV antibiotics, IV PPI, IV Antiemetics , IV Antipyretic, Antacid and other supportive treatment given. All necessary investigations was done. After patient consent and PAC clearance patient under went for surgery. Wound debridement with contracture release surgery with large SSG under GA was done on 08.01.2021. Pediatrician refferal by Dr. Shailender Prasad and ENT refferal by Dr. Virad Prasad was done. Treatment optimized accordingly. Dressing was done. Now patient condition is stable and is being

HISTORY

Mr. Aarav Yadav, 18 months, old male, patient was admitted in this hospital with complaints of fever on and off, burn injury over right leg and buttock, left buttock and lower leg, right wrist+, dehydration+, loose motion, Itching+ on burn site.
